Beginners need you to keep things simple to make them clear.

Language strategies:

- Talk about what to do, rather than what to avoid.
- Avoid using fun terms for bad techniques.
- Talk about the root cause rather than the visible outcome.
- Instead of "warm up," say "skill development time.

When working with beginners, demonstrating proficiency can be very overwhelming. Instead, use step by step images.

Avoid mnemonic devices like GBDFA, because they can make music theory seem random.
