Every single piece of music, and every note, regardless of the skill level of the musicians, can and should have these three things:

- Accurate pitch and intonation
- Beautiful tone and quality
- Expressions

## On rhythm...

- Consider having members tap pulse on neighbors' shoulder.
- Think of rhythm problems as pitch problems if the notes are in the wrong place, then the pitches and harmonies are wrong.

## On warm-ups...

- Use a passage from something you are working on.
- Make sure warm-ups use limited ranges.
- For groups who are relatively advanced, limit the warm-up time.
