Three Copyright Takeaways for K-12 Music Educators:

Simply purchasing sheet music doesn't grant recording rights.

A blanket annual license can cover all your school's musical performances for the year, eliminating the need to seek permissions for each individual concert or event.

If a specific piece of music isn't covered by your licensing service, reach out to the publisher or work with a licensing service to find a solution - and be prepared to mute that specific piece if necessary.

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
